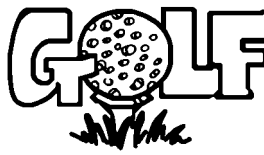

BISHOP'S APPEAL ... AND:

I want to thank all of us at OLGC who participated to date in the Bishops' Appeal. I am told that we have among the highest participation rates in the Diocese: 239 parishioner donors vs 221 last year -- an increase of 18 households. 46.68% of the parish, an increase of 4.34%, vs diocesan average of 20.92% with a diocesan increase of 2.9%. Total amount pledged by OLGC is \$67,439. This entails significant sacrifice for the diocese.

Thank you for your support to Catholic Charities, schools, seminarian-development and other concerns.

Regarding OLGC, our parish is facing some new and very significant head winds itself going forward. In the past year we grew about 100 households. Then again, there are presently about another 1,000 houses being built in the parish area. Statistically, about 10%/100 of these will become homes for practicing Catholics with an average of 3 persons per home. That means about another 300 + persons in this church building within one year. That's only the 1st wave. Right after that there are more waves coming, so it looks something like this:

- 1.) Right now we are 500 households / 1,500 parishioners
- 2.) Within a year 1,000 more houses will be built / 300 new parishioners.
- 3.) Right after that another 1,800 homes with 540 new parishioners.
- 4.) Then 3,600 homes with about 1,080 new parishioners.
- 5.) Finally -- we hope! - "Silverleaf", (right next to church) 10,700 homes with 3,210 new parishioners.

Total: 6,630 parishioners. Yikes!

Clearly within the next few years we will have to plan and build for the future. Actually, for the very near future. Do we have the heart for it? The resources? The needed solidarity? Come Holy Spirit. . . Yikes again! *Father Guy*

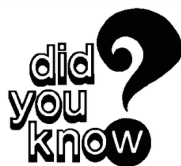

Mass Intentions: If you would like to have a Mass said for a special intention, please pick up the "Mass Intention Request Form" (printed on purple paper) found in the Church Entrance Area in the wooden wall display and drop it into the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office. The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, make check payable to Rev. Guy Francis Noonan.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required. For the next Baptismal preparation class for parents wishing to have their children baptized, please contact the Parish Office.

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.

Sacramental Preparation for First Holy Eucharist/Reconciliation & Confirmation is a two-year program. Contact Jeanne Vecchione 904-824-8688 or e-mail: olgcreledcoord@gmail.com for further information.

Stewardship Reflection:**May 10, 2015 – Sixth Sunday of Easter**

Acts 10: 25-26, 34-35, 44-48; Ps 98: 1-4; 1 Jn 4: 7-10; Jn 15: 9-17

“This I command you: love one another.” Note that in this direct quote from today’s Gospel that the Lord does not offer this as a suggestion nor as an option. It is a command. He reinforces this several times in Holy Scripture as He offers it as one of the two most important commandments. If we make an effort to genuinely love one another, we will have gone a long way to living out discipleship and stewardship.



It is appropriate on this Sixth Sunday of Easter when we celebrate Mother’s Day throughout the United States that our readings are filled with the message of love. The love of a mother is one of the great blessings anyone can receive. We should have no difficulty on this day letting our mothers — in fact, all those women who have provided support and forgiveness to us — know that we love them.
