**Gospel** — Who is this whom even wind and sea obey? (Mark 4:35-41).

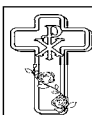

When Joseph and Lori's son Tyler was 4 years old he had a kidney transplant. Unfortunately Tyler's kidney has tired! He is now at 3% functioning and it's not good. He went through all the testing at Mayo for getting on the list. He is currently on the donor list, but it could be a wait of 4 1/2 years.

If anyone is wanting to get tested, to see if they can be a possible donor, his parents want to leave no stone unturned.

*His blood type is O.* But even if you have a different blood type, it is possible for you to be a cross match. If you do not want to speak to the parents about your decision and just want to be tested, just go to Mayo to the transplant office and make an appointment for a blood test. **"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers:** All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called *"Protecting God's Children" ("PGC")*. Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org). A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

**Marriage:** To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

**Baptism:** Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required. For the next Baptismal preparation class for parents wishing to have their children baptized, please contact the Parish Office.

**All Sponsors:** Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.

Jb 38: 1, 8-11; Ps 107: 23-26, 28-31; 2 Cor 5: 14-17; Mk 4: 35-41



Life, by its very nature, is filled with storms. In more than one Biblical account, we hear about Jesus calming a storm. Today's Gospel from St. Mark reports one of these incidents. Jesus is asleep in a boat carrying the Apostles across the Sea of Galilee.

Presumably the storm was raging and was loud, but the Lord does not awaken. We might also imagine that the Apostles are yelling and making noise in an effort to combat the terrible weather, but that does not awaken Jesus. Certainly water in rain and waves is splashing on and into the boat, but He continues to sleep. However, when they call to Him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" Jesus wakes up immediately and responds to the problem.

In the midst of the storms of our lives, we need to take the time to turn to God and ask for help. The Lord will respond. When He does, we need to be prepared for the same question He poses to His Apostles, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" We must think of the many times in our lives when the Lord has blessed us, and kept us. Our faithful response to this love should be increased trust and a sense of stewardship of the gifts with which we have been blessed.

God doesn't just "have a plan" for our salvation — He became the plan (Phil 2:6-16).
