Before beginning his studies in St. Louis, Rob worked as a house parent at a therapeutic group home for abused and neglected boys with emotional and behavioral disorders. Growing up in Jacksonville with one older brother, he credits his parents' decision to send him to Bishop Kenny High School as the first step in a long journey down the road of discipleship and into the Catholic Church.

After experiencing snow for the first time in 2013, Rob is eager to return to St. Augustine, and is very excited to work with the parishioners and staff of OLGC to continue cultivating a vibrant community of disciples."

Robert will have the opportunity to introduce himself at the end of all Masses (and at coffee and donuts) on Sunday, **August 16**. He will also at a subsequent date address the community at the 4:00 PM Saturday Mass. *Fr. Guy*

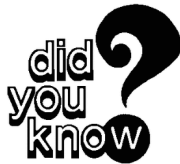

The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, make check payable to Rev. Guy Francis Noonan.

**"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers:** All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called *"Protecting God's Children" ("PGC")*. Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org). A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:  
**Retrouvaille**, 904-662-8604, [www.retrouvaille.org](http://www.retrouvaille.org)

**Marriage:** To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

**Baptism:** Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required. For the next Baptismal preparation class for parents wishing to have their children baptized, please contact the Parish Office.

**All Sponsors:** Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
