Food Pantry Changes

The Village Church has very generously designated OLGc Food Pantry as the recipient of several thousand Hunger Fight food bags. Each bag provides a meal serving 6 children or 3 adults. Each meal is extremely nutritious, being vitamin and protein enriched. They only require the addition of water and boiling for 20 to 30 minutes. We will use the Beans and Rice and Cheezy Mac meals.

By adding two bags each of these meals to our packed bags, **we will eliminate the need to collect boxed Mac 'N Cheese, canned pasta and soup** while providing an even more nutritious assortment of food. Don't worry, all those items currently in stock will be used before we introduce the new meal bags, but from now on, we ask you to concentrate on the remaining core items for our bags. *The web site has a complete list of core items needed for our packed bags.*

By refocusing our donations on fewer items we will increase the number of bags packed with our current donation level by 20%. This is a great help as we strive to serve more families each month, but we still have a significant gap to overcome to reach sustainability (donations = food given out). Thank you for your continued support of the food pantry.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required. For the next Baptismal preparation class for parents wishing to have their children baptized, please contact the Parish Office.

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
