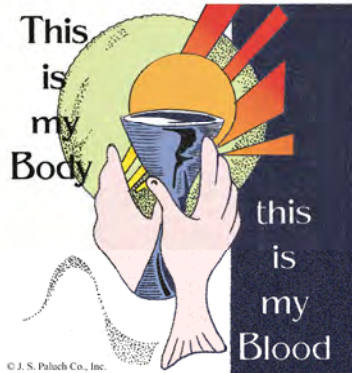

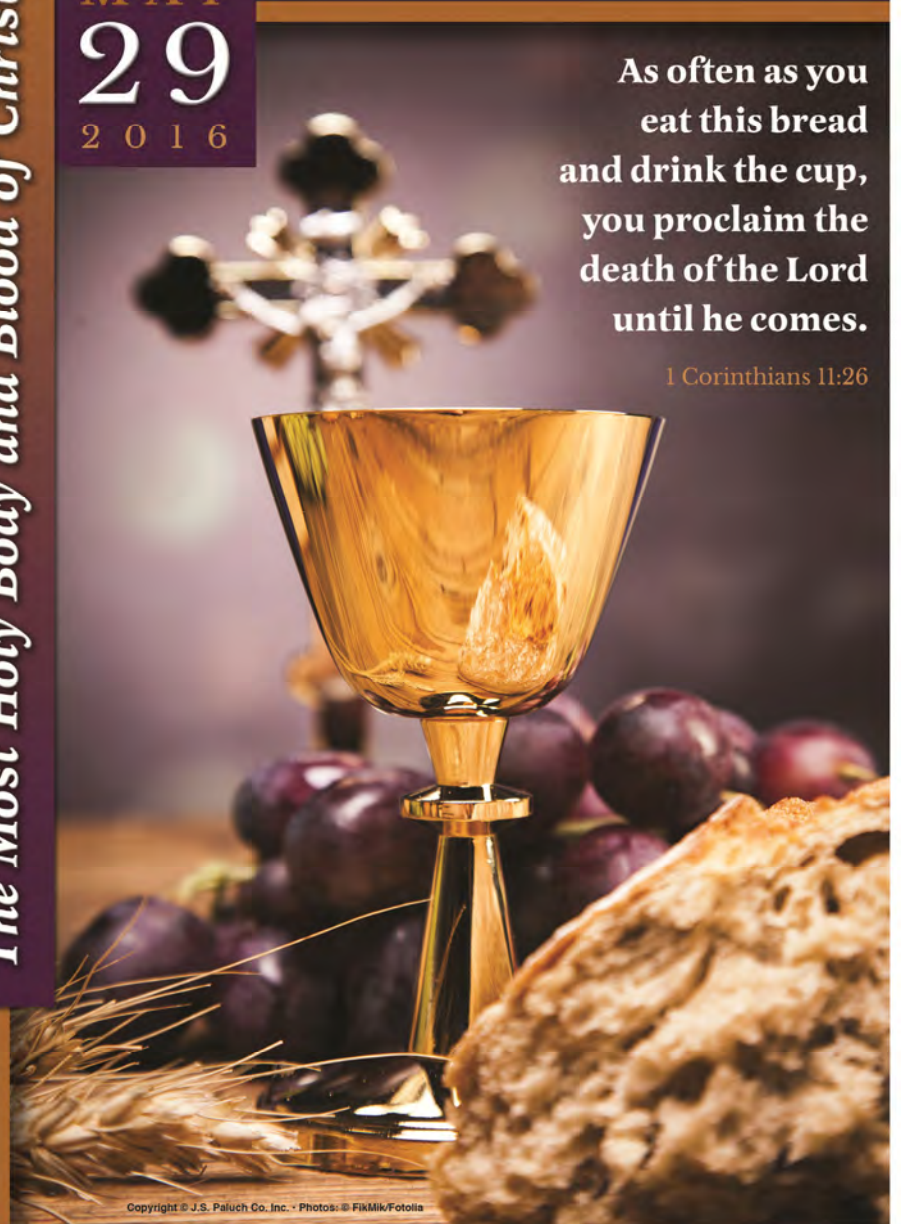

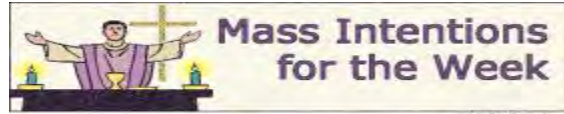
First Reading — Melchizedek, the king of Salem and a priest of God Most High, brought out bread and wine and blessed Abram (Genesis 14:18-20).

I am still looking for ***Handbell ringers***. We have seven in our group but we need 11 for a 3 octave choir. This group is open to adults and children 5th grade and up. We meet on Thursday nights from 5 pm to 6 pm. Ringing Handbells is so much fun. No excuses here folks! You need not sing nor read notes! Preteens, teens, and adults: men or women...come, bring a friend, and join in this awesome ministry!

The Adult Choir is always looking for ***more vocalists***. I now teach Music reading skills for twenty minutes before choir rehearsal on Wednesday. Come, join us and learn a new skill, meet new friends. ***We particularly need male singers***. High School students and adults welcome.

This year the Children's Choir continued throughout the year. Though small in quantity, they are big on quality! They express their music through song and movement. The current group is so good that they will be our future church leaders. I know I will have to start a new beginner group in the Fall, so please, plan for the future.

Our Orchestra has recently grown. We are working with children to teach our worship music. ***Parents, we need your help in getting the children to practice on Wednesday at 5:30 pm***. Keep them playing their instrument during the summer. It is like having free lessons!!!

In conclusion, I asked each group the question: "Would you like to continue during the summer". They all said yes!!! What a wonderful compliment that they would like to continue to serve you, the community. ***We also appreciate your support when you sing along during Mass***.

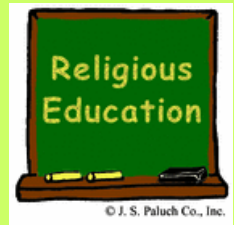
Catechist recruitment — we need you!

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called *"Protecting God's Children" ("PGC")*. Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. *Class is First Saturday at 9 am, please contact Deacon Mark Sciuillo.*

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.

Sacramental Preparation for First Holy Eucharist/Reconciliation & Confirmation is a two-year program. Contact Robert T. Sims 904-824-8688 or e-mail: olgc.rob@gmail.com for further information.
