### “Feed My People”

“Feed My People” is a Thanksgiving Day Ministry sponsored by the Men’s Club.

The focus is on low income, home bound senior citizens. Last year we served over 40 meals to 30+ families. Names are provided by Catholic Charities, the Council on Aging and the Sheriff’s Office together with suggestions from the Parish.

Here’s how it works: we provide a full Thanksgiving meal for each person (turkey and all the “fixins”). The Men’s Club purchases, prepares and packages each meal. The meals are blessed at the 10:00 am Mass on Thanksgiving Day and, with the help of Map Quest, immediately delivered to each residence by volunteer parish families. That’s it!!

Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.
