Declaration of Life signed by Father Rene on May 23, 1995:

"I hereby declare that should I die as a result of a violent crime, I request that the person or persons found guilty of homicide for my killing not be subject to or put in jeopardy of the death penalty under any circumstances, no matter how heinous their crime or how much I may have suffered."

Signature drive is the weekend Masses of November 19 & 20 and Thanksgiving Day Mass on Thursday, November 24.

Diocese of Saint Augustine Office of the Bishop and the Presbyteral Council has approved a diocesan wide signature drive to be delivered to the Public Prosecutor's Office of Burke County Georgia.

Not all parishioners agree with the death penalty while others may approve. We are not seeking parishioners to approve or disapprove of the death penalty itself, but simply in this case it would not be pursued.


We come to the end of the Jubilee Year of Mercy, when Our Holy Father has expressly underlined and emphasized Mercy in his Bull of Indiction at the beginning of the Jubilee Year. This petition on behalf of the Catholic Community of this Diocese will lend a very timely and appropriate means to underscore and emphasize the need for mercy in all its implications for our church and the society in which we live.

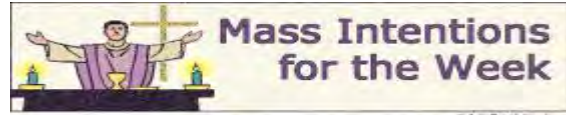

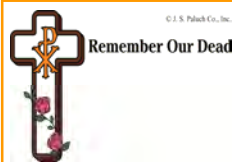

Here's how it works: we provide a full Thanksgiving meal for each person (turkey and all the "fixins"). The Men's Club purchases, prepares and packages each meal. The meals are blessed at the 10:00 am Mass on Thanksgiving Day and, with the help of Map Quest, immediately delivered to each residence by volunteer parish families. That's it!!

All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.
