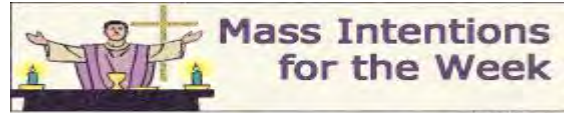

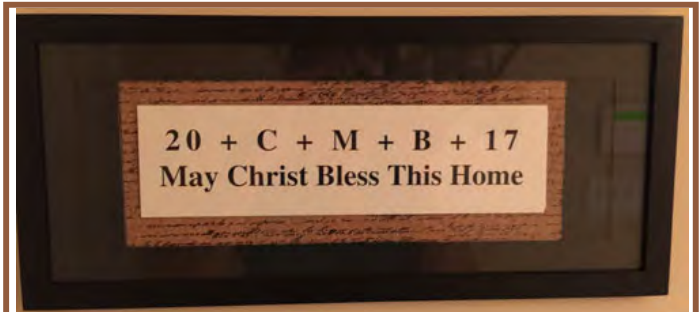

Dear Parishioners,

A good number of years ago I asked whether there might be interest in doing some social service ministry projects both within the parish area and also internationally, specifically in **Haiti**. There were a number of parishioners interested in one or the other of these regards.



Unfortunately the 'great' recession entered in around the same time and so many people and programs and projects have taken years to recover. Here at OLGC we are no different -- we lost 100 households or 20% of our parish at the time. It has taken us until now to recover from that.

In the interest of re-opening these areas of possibility we have scheduled an evening session of information regarding one well-established Haitian project entitled the "**Community Coalition for Haiti**".

Invited to this session as our presenters will be Doctor Wayne Reichman, vascular surgeon, and his wife Vickie. Both Wayne and Vickie are deeply involved in this Haitian project. They now divide their residence between here (Palencia) and Baltimore, Maryland.

The date is **Monday, January 16th. The time is 7:00 PM to 8:30+** in the main OLGC Church. Altar serving is a very important and much needed role in the ministry of the church. Altar servers have many roles, including carrying the cross and the processional candles, holding the book for the priest celebrant when he is not at

the altar, carrying the incense and censer, presenting the bread, wine, and water to the priest during the preparation of the gifts and assisting him when he receives the gifts from the people, washes the hands of the priest, and assists the priest celebrant and deacon as necessary.

Pope Francis tells people that, "serving is a privileged way to draw closer to Jesus. The closer you are to the altar, the more you will remember to speak with Jesus in daily prayer; the more you will be nourished by the word and the body of the Lord, the better able you will be to go out to others, bringing them the gift that you have received, giving in turn with enthusiasm the joy you have received".

YEAR END CHARITABLE DONATIONS:

Are you at least 70.5 years old?

- Pay no later than December 31, 2016.
- Total charitable distributions from your IRA may not exceed \$100,000 per year; other than this limit, distributions may be in any amount.
- Distributions must be made directly from the IRA custodian to qualified non-profit.
- Distributions must be outright charitable gifts (vs. contributions to funding annuities and other planned giving arrangements, which do not qualify).

Who is most likely to be motivated to make a charitable gift from an IRA?

Generally speaking, individuals 70.5 and older who are required to take IRA distributions, but who do not need or want the taxable income from that source, may find the IRA gift opportunity attractive — especially if they do not itemize deductions.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:

Retrouvaille 904-662-8604, www.retrouvaille.org

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course.
