

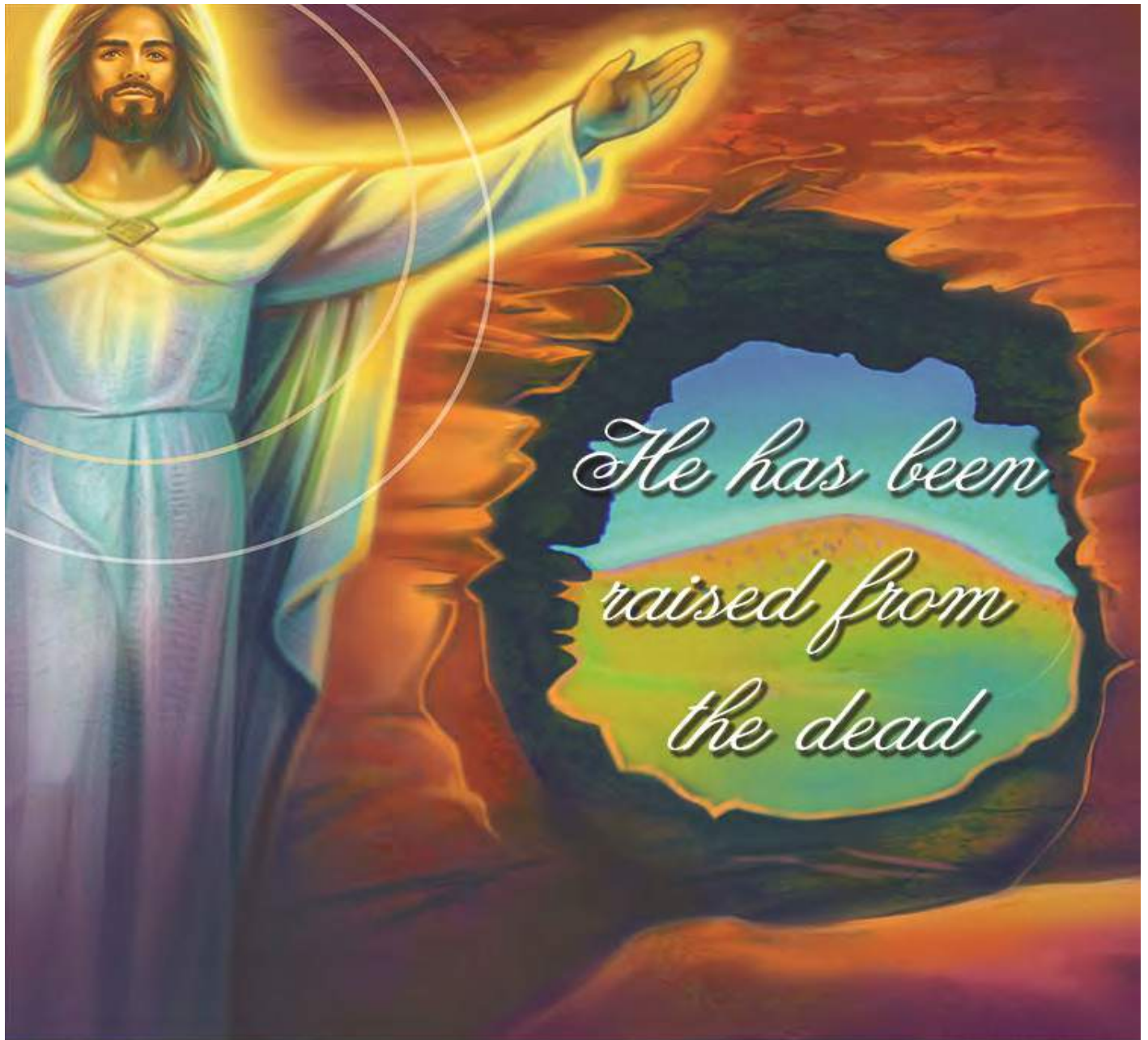

Divine Mercy Sunday - April 23, 2017

"Our mission on Earth is to share God's mercy with others." While He is always so generously pouring out His love and mercy on us - every single day - there is at least one day in particular when He does so in an extraordinary way: Divine Mercy Sunday. Divine Mercy Sunday is April 23 and now is a great time to prepare to receive its extraordinary graces. Regarding this grace-filled day, Jesus says to St. Faustina in her diary:

"On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, 669).

This is great news! Jesus is saying that if we go to confession (preferably during the week before Divine Mercy Sunday), are in a state of grace, and receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday (April 23) with the desire to receive the graces of His promise, then we shall receive them. (Fr. Joseph, MIC)

The Divine Mercy Novena began on **Good Friday, April 14, and ends Saturday, April 22**. You can say the Novena at any time of day in your own home, but preferably at 3 PM as this is the Hour of Great Mercy.

May you have a blessed Easter, and a grace-filled Divine Mercy Sunday!

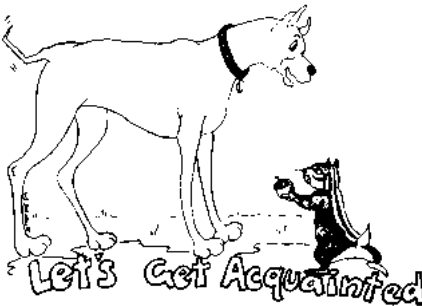

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.
