Second Reading — Once we were like straying sheep; but now we have been returned to the shepherd, our guardian (1 Peter 2:20b-25).

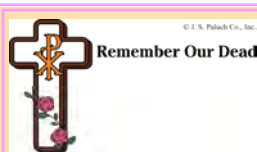
Gospel — The shepherd leads the sheep out into pastures of abundant life (John 10:1-10).

MAJOR CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

A Christian, to be such, must be united with Christ and with his fellowman. We strive for this union in the Mass. The liturgy has sometimes been reduced to an empty shell, missing the core elements of what it means to be a member of the Body of Christ. Excellent organization, perfect order and good music is not sufficient. It cannot replace worship that calls people to Gospel values – to give up all, especially materialism and consumer lifestyles, to follow Jesus. Certainly beauty is very important in worship, but the message of the Gospel and the unity of all members of the Body of Christ, especially the suffering, must never be obscured. Thus, the liturgy is more than the worship of the Body of Christ, but must be inextricably linked with the Church's teaching on service to the poor, charity and justice. This is not only the antidote to materialism, individualism and indifference to justice, but is what leads to transforming our lives, which requires more than merely taking old clothes to a shelter, or taking courses on social justice. Justice is not derived from the Christ-life, it is the embodiment of the Christ life in us.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Class is First Saturday at 9 am, please contact Deacon Mark Sciullo: mvsциullo1981@gmail.com**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be **active** Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an **active** Catholic at OLGC.
