Saint for Sunday, August 14, 2016

August Saint of Mercy

St. Maximilian Kolbe

Raymund Kolbe was ordained a Franciscan priest in 1918, taking the name Maximilian. After studying in Rome, Maximilian returned to Poland. During World War II, Father Kolbe hid as many as 2,000 Jewish people and Poles in his Polish monastery. In 1941, Maximilian was arrested by the Nazis, who sent him to Auschwitz. When several prisoners escaped, the commander picked 10 men to be starved as punishment. Franciszek Gajowniczek, a husband and father, was one of these. Fr. Kolbe offered his life in this man's place. When Kolbe outlived many of the men, he was killed by lethal injection. In 1982, Pope St. John Paul II canonized Maximilian Kolbe as a "martyr of charity." Present at the ceremony was Gajowniczek, who had lived 54 years after St. Maximilian had taken his place in death.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGc Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:

Retrouvaille 904-662-8604, www.retrouvaille.org

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Class is First Saturday at 9 am, please contact Deacon Mark Sciuolo.**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be **active** Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an **active** Catholic at OLGc. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.

Sacramental Preparation for First Holy Eucharist/Reconciliation & Confirmation is a two-year program. Contact Donald Pepino 904-824-8688 or e-mail: olgc.don@gmail.com for further information.
