We are beginning a new ministry at OLG. This ministry is in support of and encouragement for priestly and religious vocations, while strengthening the family through prayer. Here is how it works.



Families will sign up to pray for vocations. At the end of Mass, the designated family would receive the **Vocation Chalice**. During the week, the family with the chalice would pray for vocations. On the following Sunday (or Saturday), they would bring the chalice back and a new family would receive the chalice for the following week. Each of the Masses will have a designated chalice. So during each week, OLG will have at least four families praying for vocations.

We are looking for coordinators (individuals or couple) for each Mass. The Coordinator will make sure the chalice for the particular Mass gets exchanged to the next family. The coordinator will also sign up volunteer families and maintain the schedule, as well as become part of the **Vocations Committee**. This committee will meet occasionally to discuss different ways to promote and encourage priestly and religious vocations.

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGC Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.
