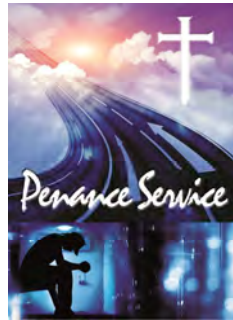

LENTEN SEASON FRIDAY FISH AND SHRIMP DINNERS

For the 15th consecutive year, Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church community (OLGC) will offer their traditional Lenten Fish and Shrimp Dinners during the six Fridays of Lent beginning March 3rd and concluding April 7th. Meals will be available at \$11.00 for eat-in or take-out.

Lunch will be served from 11:00 am through 1:00 pm. Lunch items include fried cod fish, fried shrimp or a combination of fried fish and shrimp.

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Class is First Saturday at 9 am, please contact Deacon Mark Sciullo: mvsциullo1981@gmail.com**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be **active** Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an **active** Catholic at OLGC. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
