

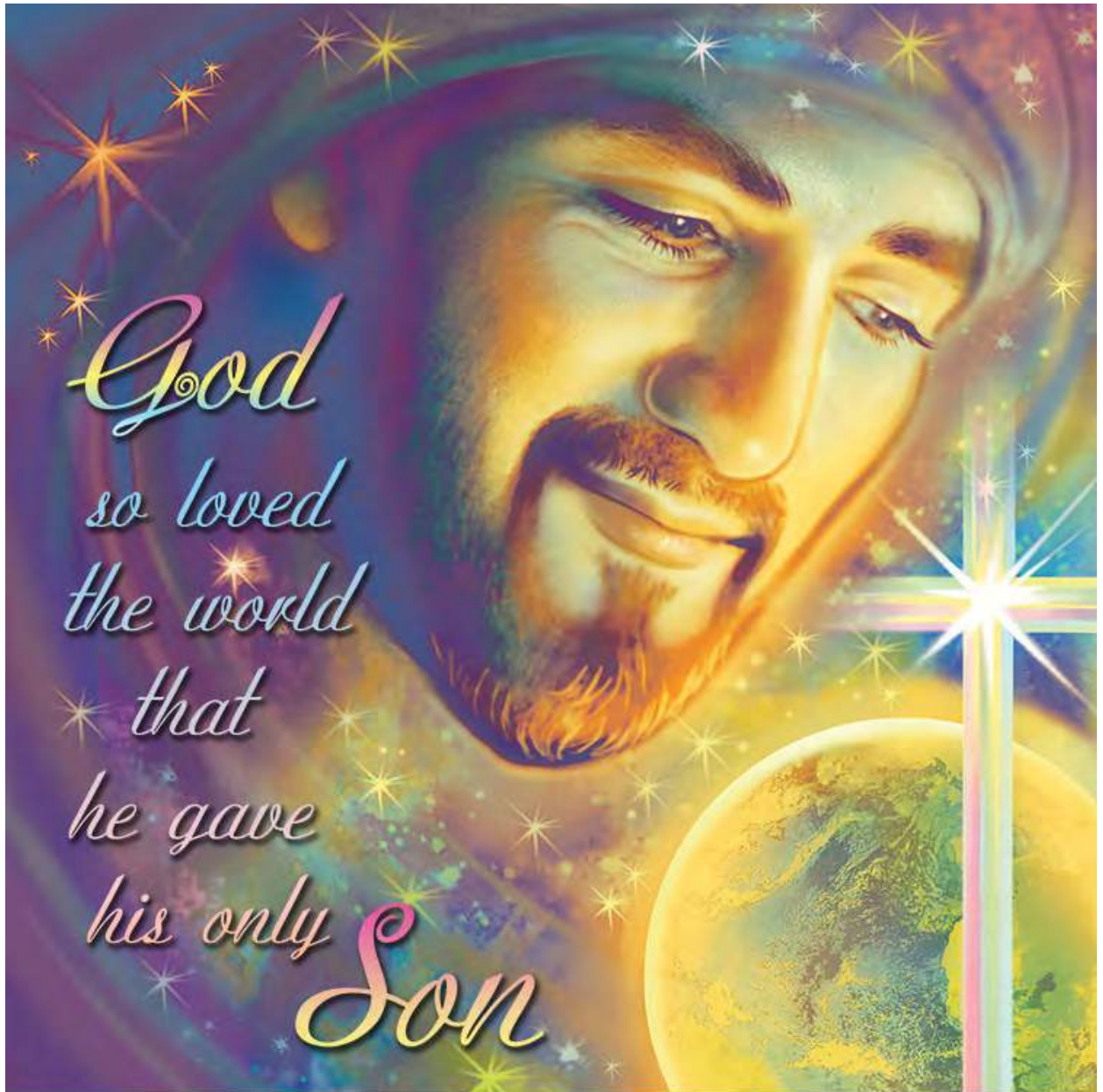

MAJOR REPAIRS ON BUILDING: Our present church/hall was built in 2000, thus making the building now 17 years old. Much maintenance and repair is needed to keep on top of a building as it ages. An engineering study was done on the whole facility last year. This study suggests and details certain repairs to be undertaken consecutively over the next 5 to 10 years.

One of the major repair needed pertains to exterior doors and the metal siding from the ground up. The metal at the bottom, where it touches the concrete slab, is significantly rusted and deteriorated. In the next week or two we will be removing approximately 4 feet of lower external metal paneling in a number of areas of the building. The removed panels will be replaced with panels of a different color. This will then "be married" to the original remaining upper panels by means of a piece of metal fabricated precisely for this purpose.

These repairs are expensive. Between the doors and the panels the estimated cost is about \$30,000.00.

I thank those of you who regularly support the parish according to your means. I encourage those who do not support the parish to make a decision for solidarity. Just as with your home, all enjoy the use of the space, and all should do their best to care for it.

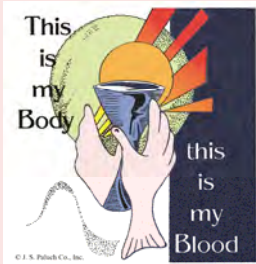

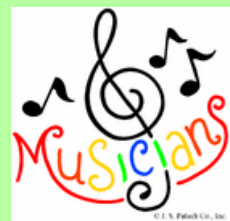

"Protecting God's Children" Requirement for Volunteers: All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLGc Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

A Program for Troubled Marriages:

Marriage: To schedule a wedding, engaged couples must meet with their Pastor at least 8 months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Class is First Saturday at 9 am, please contact Deacon Mark Sciullo: mvsциullo1981@gmail.com**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be **active** Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an **active** Catholic at OLGc. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
