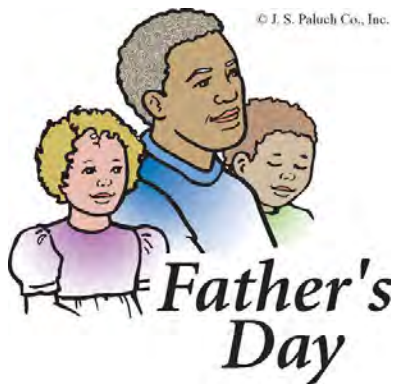

 Europeans brought a deadly cargo with them: diseases which the Taino people had no immunity to combat: smallpox, typhoid fever, yellow fever, to name a few. 16 years after Columbus' arrival the Taino population had fallen from 400,000 to just 65,000. By 1518 less than 3,000 Tainos remained alive on Hispaniola.

**New Baptismal Bowl and Font:** You will see a new baptismal bowl at the entry of the church. The bowl is hand made in a studio on an island off the coast of Washington State, and the design is called "Sea Foam". It took quite a while to realize production because in the middle of the process one of the artists had a stroke and needed time for recovery.

**CHARLIE HUNTER** did the beautiful work of designing with me the furniture piece upon which the bowl sits. Notice also the three oils (Oil of the Catechumens, Oil of the Infirm (sick) and the Sacred Chrism) are all contained within the baptismal font itself. There is also an inscription which comes from the baptismal ritual: "✠The Christian Community welcomes you with great joy. ✠In its name, I claim you for Christ by the sign of His cross.✠". As agreed, Charlie was able to place the font on hidden wheels. Thus, it can be easily moved as need be for baptisms and other needs. Thank you, Charlie, for this creativity.

[Charlie was also the Team Leader for redoing the vestiges of the high altar from the historic church, now in our sanctuary. He also designed and made the artistically designed table next to the Celebrant Presider's chair]. *Father Guy*

**Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children":** All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC").
