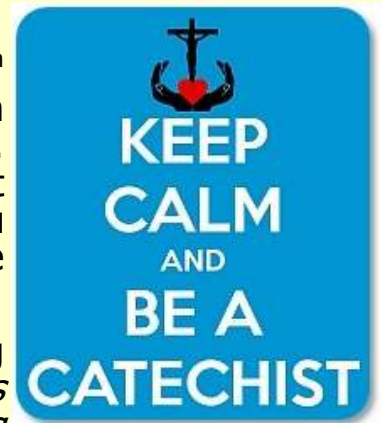
**Be a Part of the Religious Education Team!**
